Safety Groups is a performance-based rebate program developed by the Workplace Safety and Insurance Board (WSIB). The program offers participating firms the opportunity to receive rebates of up to 7% of the group's pooled WSIB premiums if they can collectively improve their health and safety performance and implemented the required health and safety elements.

Each safety group has a sponsor that leads and coordinates the group. At the beginning of each year, firms select five elements that they believe are specific to their organization's needs and will improve their health and safety performance. Firms will learn how to implement these elements through "Five Steps to Managing Health & Safety" as well as at the sponsored meetings and through the sharing of ideas and resources with other firms in their safety group.

- Decreases WSIB costs and claims
- Become more competitive in your market
- Show management support for Health & Safety in the workplace
- Create a culture of Health & Safety by meeting Occupational Health & Safety requirements
- Earn a financial rebate
- Improves quality, quantity of work, and worker moral

- Ability to maintain a healthy and stable workforce

Your Role in the Group?

- Commit to the program one year at a time.
- Be a Schedule 1 firm; a group consists of at least 40 schedule 1 companies in good standing with the WSIB and with a minimum combined WSIB premium of \$250 000.
- Pay a registration fee to cover administration fees and goals.
- Implement 5 elements a year following the 5-step system.
- The safety group meets five times a year; you must attend at least three of these meetings.
- After 5 years of successful completion of the program you will have 25-elements that are in line with your business needs and the legislation.
